- a. provides an exemption from Western Australian Import Requirement Condition ID 03 (not SA, NT) *Dothistroma* Needle Blight (*Dothistroma septospora*)
- b. provides an exemption from Western Australian Import Requirement Condition ID 55 (QW & NT) Spiraling Whitefly
- c. provides an exemption from Western Australian Import Requirement Condition ID C28 (QW & NT) Spiraling Whitefly-for Condition 55.

2) Consignment to be accompanied by a copy of this permit.

3) The consignment to be clearly marked 'Present to Quarantine WA for inspection'. Inspections take place during core business hours of 7:30 am and prior to 4:00 pm Monday to Friday, and excluding Statutory Western Australian Government Public Holidays.

4) Contact Quarantine WA via email (followup@agric.wa.gov.au) or phone (08) 9334 1800 at least 24 hours prior to import with the following information:

- a. permit number
- b. exporter and importer names, addresses and phone contact details
- c. expected date and time of arrival
- d. mode of transport and entry point.

5) Consignment must be free from quarantine risk material.

6) Consignment must meet all other relevant import requirements. Western Australian Import Requirements are available from <https://www.agric.wa.gov.au/iaquarantine/>.
